

A Report on the *Diksharambha* (Induction Programme) of Bongaigaon University, 18/08/2026



Bongaigaon University organised a *Diksharambha* (Induction Programme) on 18th August, 2026 to formally welcome and orient the undergraduate and postgraduate students of the University at the beginning of the academic session 2026-2027. The programme brought together the university authorities, faculty members, the chief guest and students for an informative and engaging session.

The programme commenced with the arrival and seating of the Vice-Chancellor Prof. Taranee Deka, Registrar Dr. Dinesh Das and Chief Guest Dr. Bhushan Chandra Pathak, a distinguished academician, author and the Principal of renowned B. H. College, Barpeta. Dr. Chinmoy Bhattacharjee, Principal of Birjhora Mahavidyalaya, the Science Campus of the University, also joined them.
